

VascularScreening

Nationally Recognized Vascular Lab

St. Luke's Vascular Lab is accredited by the Intersocietal Accreditation Commission and is committed to high quality patient care through diagnostic imaging. We meet nationally recognized standards on state-of-theart ultrasound equipment.

Early detection and proactive management of vascular disease is a key part of maintaining a healthy lifestyle. We offer three types of vascular screenings to help detect vascular disease. They include:

- · Carotid Artery Disease screening
- Peripheral Artery Disease (PAD) screening
- · Abdominal Aortic Aneurysms (AAA) screening

All three screenings together last approximately 45 minutes and are painless procedures that use ultrasound technology. All exams are performed by registered vascular technologists. Results are read by boardcertified, vascular surgeons, with results sent to your home within one week.

Risk Factors for Vascular Disease

You should consider a vascular screening if you have any of the following risk factors:

- Age (50 years or older)
- Smoking
- High blood pressure
- Diabetes
- Obesity
- High cholesterol
- Family history for strokes, abdominal aortic aneurysm and heart disease
- Prior heart attack, bypass operation or coronary stent



Important Facts About Vascular Disease

Carotid artery disease is one of the leading causes of stroke. Most patients with significant carotid artery disease don't have any symptoms. This is what makes screening for the disease so valuable. Carotid ultrasound can detect these significant blockages before they lead to strokes.

Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD) occurs when plaque deposits block arteries in the legs. The condition can be painful when walking or at rest and also can cause wounds to heal poorly. Smokers, former smokers, and diabetics are especially prone to PAD. PAD can be detected during a vascular screening.

Abdominal aortic aneurysms (AAA) occur when the wall of the largest artery in the body (aorta) weakens and starts to balloon. Left untreated, AAAs continue to dilate and can rupture. Less than 10 percent of patients with a ruptured aneurysm survive.

Most patients with AAAs don't have any symptoms, so screening ultrasounds are an important tool in the early detection and ultimate repair of aneurysms before they rupture.

Digital Mobile Mammography Van

The St. Luke's Hospital Mobile Mammography Van makes getting a mammogram more convenient by coming directly to you. St. Luke's van can be scheduled for visits to businesses, schools and other organizations as a standalone employee health offering or as part of an existing St. Luke's Healthy Workforce Employee Wellness partnership. Help your employees get the preventive healthcare they need right on site in just 15 minutes rather than taking a half day away from work.



The Mobile Mammography Unit visits various community sites all over the greater St. Louis area including each of the St. Luke's Urgent Care Centers.

- St. Luke's Mobile Mammography Van offers 3D screening mammograms for women ages 40 and over.
- The Mobile Mammography Van can be scheduled Monday through Friday.
- St. Luke's provides promotional materials for van visits, and patients call a dedicated phone line to schedule an appointment for the event.
- There is no charge to the business or employer for having the Mobile Mammography Van come on site.
- As of January 2019, annual screening 3D mammograms are a covered benefit under all insurances in the state of Missouri.
- Most insurances are accepted. St. Luke's will submit all claims to participating insurance companies.
- St. Luke's Hospital is committed to saving lives through early detection. Women who are uninsured may be eligible for free mammograms.
